This work must be an original research article published in an SCIE-indexed journal after August 1, 2020, with the applicant as the first or corresponding author. If the work is co-authored, a "Verification of Co-author's Contribution to the Applicant's Representative Publication" is required (http://www.personnel.ntu.edu.tw/News Content n 165 s 5117.html). For Assistant Professor applicants, the doctoral dissertation may serve as the representative work.
- 4. **Transcripts** from undergraduate and graduate programs (for applicants applying for the rank of Assistant Professor). If your institution did not require coursework, please provide supporting documents from the university or your advisor.

- 5. Photocopy of Ph.D. Diploma.
- 6. **Proposed Courses** including course titles and outlines/syllabi.
- 7. **Research Proposal** outlining future research plans.
- 8. **Reprints of Publications** published within the past seven years (after August 1, 2018).
